


## **Update to COVID-19 Competition Action Plan**

### **ATTENTION**

## CDC Announcement and New Update to the USEF COVID-19 Action Plan Regarding Fully-Vaccinated Participants

Dear US Equestrian members,

Yesterday, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) announced that anyone who is fully vaccinated against COVID-19 can participate in indoor and outdoor activities, large or small, without wearing a face covering/mask or physically distancing. An individual is considered to be fully vaccinated two weeks after their second dose in a two-dose series (Pfizer, Moderna, etc.), or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine (Johnson & Johnson). If you have not been vaccinated yet, and are looking for a place to do so, click to find a vaccine.

Based on this very encouraging news and the rapidly changing guidance from national health authorities, effective immediately, USEF is amending the COVID-19 Action Plan to align with the CDC announcement. At a minimum, competition organizers and all persons at USEF-licensed competitions are required to follow state and local regulations for face coverings/masks and social distancing. In the absence of state and local regulations, USEF recommends compliance with the CDC guidelines. Competition organizers are able to impose stricter requirements at their discretion.

Personal responsibility is essential, as competition organizers are not required to verify vaccination status. Let's all continue to act responsibly and keep our sport open, and our nation moving forward in a positive manner.

A few reminders as we move forward:

- •Be patient with and respectful of competition organizers, competition staff, and licensed officials as competitions transition to this new protocol. Adjustments may not be immediate and competition organizers are able to impose stricter requirements at their discretion.
- •Competition organizers must post and communicate to competition staff, competitors, officials and spectators the COVID requirements under which their competition will operate.
- •Anyone who is not fully vaccinated must exercise personal responsibility and wear a face covering/mask wearing and continue to practice social distancing and frequent hand washing.

We would like to acknowledge and thank our members, competition organizers and their staff, licensed officials, the USEF staff, and the entire equestrian community who effectively implemented the COVID-19 Action Plan over the past year, helping to ensure a safe environment for competitions and participants.

A fully updated version of the USEF COVID-19 Action Plan will be posted to the USEF website no later than close of business on Tuesday, May 18.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF/EC RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

Any changes or corrections after the publication of this prize list for ANY rules will automatically become part of this prize list and will appear on the Region 8 website (www.AHAregion8.org).

### **AHA REGION 8 LEAD-IN AND CHAMPIONSHIP SHOWS 2021**

For AHA purposes, the Region 8 Lead-In and Championship Shows will be divided into two separate shows. Lead-In Show, AHA recognition #210815422the class numbers will run from Class #300 through Class #415. Region 8 Championship Show, AHA recognition #210515314, the class numbers will run from Class #1 through Class #180.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. .

**USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:** By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Each Competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association Recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA Membership Competition Card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership fee per competitor.

When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA Recognized Competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership..

Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National Competitions.

Exhibitors in Walk-Trot Classes are exempt from AHA Membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA Membership with Competition Card at AHA Regional and Nationals Competitions.

Exhibitors in Lead Line Classes or Parents/Guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA Membership requirements. (BOD 5/12)

### **FARM/BUSINESS OWNERS:**

- 1. If your horse shows under the ownership of a farm or other business entity, the farm or other business entity must be recorded with USEF or you must pay a Show Pass fee to participate in a USEF licensed competition.
- 2. The owner of the farm or business must be on the USEF farm certificate and does not need a USEF individual membership UNLESS he/she is showing at the USEF licensed competition.
- 3. You may choose not to record your Farm or Business entity and continue to pay the required Show Pass fee. Under this option, you are not eligible for USEF points, awards, etc.

### **ENTRIES**

CANCELLATION/SUBSTITUTION OF ENTRIES: Management agrees to cancel and refund all fees, except the office fee, on any horse, provided a vet certificate is given to the Show Secretary prior to the start of the show. Subsequent to the start of the show, only a vet out by the show veterinarian will be accepted, and only the fees for remaining classes entered will be refunded. Substitution of horses will be permitted in accordance with current US Equestrian Federation rules.

ENTRIES CLOSE July 30 2021 and must be postmarked no later than that date to avoid any post fee.

Post entry fees per horse are as follows:

Postmarked from July 31 to August 10 \$40.00 per horse
Postmarked from Aug 11 Aug 17 2 pm \$60.00 per horse
\*\*\* ONLY the horse post fee is due. The last class fee is not due

LATE CLASS ENTRIES Entires for added classes for entered horses will be accepted once the show starts as follows:

### **LEAD IN CLASSES**

After Tuesday 8/17 2 PM to the end of the session prior to the class \$10.00 plus the class fee \$25.00 plus the class fee

### **REGION 8 CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES**

After Tuesday 8/17 2 PM to the end of the session prior to the class \$70.00 plus the class fee \$100.00 plus the class fee

CHECK IN All exhibitors are to leave a form of payment at check in before back numbers are given out.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: All owners, trainers, riders, drivers and handlers must provide copies of their current US Equestrian Federation or EC membership cards or pay non-member fees.

**AMATEUR NON MEMBER:** Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation.

Effective 12/1/2013, a non-member who wishes to participate in a USEF competition must pay a Show Pass fee (\$45) in lieu of a USEF non-member fee. Please refer to USEF GR 801 for further information and USEF GR 901.9 for exceptions.

AGE OF EXHIBITOR The age of an individual on December 1, 2020 will be maintained throughout the entire competition year.

**REGION 8 QUALIFICATIONS:** Qualifications have been waived for 2021. Riders must still meet the definition of Select, Choice or Elite.

**REFUSAL OF ENTRIES:** USEF GR 914 In addition to entries of persons suspended or expelled from the Federation, a Licensed Competition may refuse any entry of an exhibitor or the participation of any agent, trainer, rider, driver, or handler who has shown an objectionable attitude or behavior at a Licensed Competition or towards its management, which management is able to substantiate, or previous unsportsmanlike behavior at a Licensed Competition which management is able to substantiate.

**REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS:** A copy of both sides of the registration papers showing proof of ownership is required for each horse entered. All horses exhibited in AOTR/JOTR classes must have horse's registration papers in the exhibitor's or a family member's name.

SCRATCHED CLASSES: - A \$25.00 fee will be assessed (per class) to exhibitors who do not show up for their scheduled class and have not officially scratched their entry at the Show Office prior to the class being called to the gate.

**TBA's and SPECIALTY DIVISIONS - MINIMUM NUMBER OF ENTRIES:** Must have 3 or more horses entered as of August 18, 2021 for the class to be held or it may be cancelled.

LEAD IN SHOW TBAs (To Be Announced): Any class on the AHA Class List or recognized by AHA that is not on the Lead-In Tentative Class Schedule will be available for TBA placement, with the exception of Dressage, Sport Horse, over fences, or any class that requires cow work. It will take a minimum of a \$35 sponsorship to put a TBA class into the schedule. Sponsorship of the class is considered the entry fee for the sponsoring exhibitor. The decision will be made by the show committee based on the TBA requests received by the close of the entries on July 30, 2021.

Prior to the start of the show, Tuesday, August 17, class names and their time slots will be posted at the secretary's office. Additional entries into these classes may be made at the pre-entry fee of \$25 for non-sponsoring exhibitors. If entries are made after the closing of advance entries, post entry fees will be charged.

### **CONDUCT & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS**

CLASS CALLS: Due to unforeseeable problems with any device, the public address system and the paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working public address system to carry class calls.

**LUNGEING:** Will not be allowed in the paddock area during show hours. Lungeing areas will be provided outside the Event Center and in the Expo Hall and Stadium work areas.

**LEAD-LINE:** For rules of conduct, attire, etc., see current USEF rule book. Riders must be 2 to 6 years of age, as of Dec 1, 2020. May be entered up until the beginning of the session in which the class is held, as long as the horse the child is riding has previously been entered in the Region 8 Championship Show and has been issued a show number.

JUNIOR HORSE Open to horses 5 & Under.

SCORING The Majority Opinion System (MOS) will be used for all classes except as noted under the class information.

BREEDING/IN HAND CLASSES: When adjudicating all Breeding/ Gelding In-Hand classes, judges will use the Comparative Judging and MOS to determine final placings for Champion and Reserve Champion and Top Five. Refer REQ 215 Classes will be conducted according to the current US Equestrian Federation Rule Book. All entries will enter the ring in Birth-dates Order, the oldest horse to youngest. Halter orders of go will be posted prior to the class. Birth-dates duplication will result in back-to-back placement in the order. All horses will be inspected for signs of abuse and/or any illegalities, immediately before entering the ring for judging, by the USEF Steward.

PERFORMANCE HALTER CLASSES: Horses will be judged using the Arabian and Half-Arabian Performance Halter Scorecard. Detailed rules and specifications may be found at USEF AR.123-124 or by contacting the show management. The scorecards will be turned into placings and run through MOS to determine final final placings for Champion and Reserve Champion and Top Five. All horses 3 years of age and older must be entered and show in a performance class at the same show as the one in which the performance halter class is being held. No whips or other attention getting devices are allowed. Horses will be presented in a relaxed and dignified manner. No hard stand-ups will be permitted.

JACKPOT CLASSES: Open to both AAOTR & JOTR exhibitors. The classes will be combined with Arabians and Half-Arabians showing together. 100% of the entry fees will be paid back to the exhibitors through 5th place. Distribution as follows with the 1st place receiving 45%, 2nd 25% and 3rd-5th 10% each. JACKPOT classes are LOCAL RULES DESIGNATED but shall follow AHA and USEF rules, and, as such, do not garner points or qualifications.

**WORKING WESTERN CLASSES:** Will be judged by the judge designated as the Working Western Judge. The scoring system as defied by USEF AR 26 Working Western Section and AHA REQ 214 will be utilized.

All Reining and Reining Seat Equitation classes will utilize the current NRHA patterns.

### **CONDUCT & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS cont'd**

COLORADO ARABIAN BREEDERS ALLIANCE BREEDERS CHALLENGE FUTURITY: CABA Futurity Classes are LOCAL RULES DESIGNATED but shall follow AHA and USEF rules, and, as such, do not garner points or qualifications. Please refer to the CABA pages in this premium for details, including entry deadlines and CABA Secretary information.

MILE HIGH ENGLISH PAYBACK: The following classes will have money paid: Arabian English Pleasure Open, Junior Horse and AAOTR; Half-Arabian English Pleasure Open, Junior Horse and AAOTR; Arabian Country English Pleasure Open, Junior Horse and AAOTR; Half-Arabian Country English Pleasure Open, Junior Horse and AAOTR. Payback will be offered as follows: \$3,000 to the Champion and \$1,000 to the Reserve Champion. This payback has been generously sponsored by GCI Contracting to promote the Region 8 Championships, the Arabian and the Half-Arabian horse.

**ELIMINATIONS/CLASS SPLITS:** Eliminations for classes which may need to be split, will be held where the class is scheduled, with a final held at a later time.

**EQUITATION CLASSES:** Will be conducted according to the current AHA Handbook Rules. Rail work and Individual work will be required in Western Horsemanship, Saddle Seat, Reining Seat, and Hunter Seat Not To Jump. Note: Walk/ Trot/Jog Equitation Classes will not require individual pattern work.

AWARDS: A rose blanket and ribbon will be awarded to the Regional Champion. The reserve Champion will receive a rose garland and ribbon.

Unanimous ribbons will be awarded to horses who are first on all three cards in classes of five or more.

Top five ribbons will be awarded regardless of the number of the entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA Horse Achievement Award, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse, Achievement Award, High Point Amateur and Distance Award Points. The Lead-In show will be acknowledged with 1st and 2nd place awards. 1st-6th will be recorded and announced.

**CONCURRENT CLASSES:** REGION 8 TRAIL & REGION 8 REINING WILL HAVE CONCURRENT CLASSES. Eligible riders may enter either or both of the concurrent classes and scores will be attributed to the appropriate class(s). It is not mandatory that exhibitors enter both classes. Refer to Class List for Concurrent classes.

**ORDER OF GO:** A Random order of go will be determined in the following classes: Showmanship, Horsemanship and Equitation classes.

An electronic order of go will be determined in the following classes according to USEF AR 208.1: Trail, Reining, Reining Seat Equitation and Ranch Horse riding.

STALLIONS: Will not be allowed in Showmanship, Lead Line and Walk /Trot/Jog classes.

PADDOCK: The Paddock Master's directions must be followed at all times.

### ATTENTION COMPETITORS

**USEF Safe Sport Training Requirements** 

Starting January 1, 2019, if you are a USEF competing Member 18 years of age or older you are required to complete the Safe Sport Training within 30 days of activating your membership.

If you do not complete the training, you are ineligible to participate in all USEF activities including competitions

Take the Safe Sport Training at <u>USEF.org</u> by logging into your member dashboard.

### **CONDUCT & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS**

### **VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS**

- a. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian
- b. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
- c. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
- d. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

### HANDICAPPED & ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES

- 1. Electronic communication devices used for purposes of coaching exhibitors during a competition are prohibited in all classes in the Arabian Division. Exhibitors with a permanent hearing impairment are permitted to use an electronic communication device upon submission of a written certification from a treating medical professional's office certifying the permanent hearing impairment and certifying the requirement of an electronic communication device. The medical certification must be provided to the competition Steward within a reasonable time prior to competing who shall attach a copy to the Steward report.
- 2. Individuals must include their USEF Dispensation Certificate with entries if requiring special adaptations. See USEF and Equestrian Canada Rule Books.
- 3. An exhibitor with a disability (other than hearing) will be provided reasonable accommodation upon submission of a written certification from a treating medical professional 's office certifying the disability and identifying the accommodation necessary for the exhibitor to compete safely. The medical certification must be provided to the competition Steward within a reasonable time prior to competing who shall attach a copy to the Steward report.

### **FACILITIES**

**NO SMOKING:** The National Western Complex is designated a non-smoking facility. Smoking is not allowed in any of the buildings; including the stall areas.

**STABLING:** ALL HORSES MUST BE STABLED: Preferential stalling available in the Events Center at \$130.00 per stall (dirt floors). Preferential stalling will be given to patrons based upon priority order among patrons. After patron stalls are assigned, the remainder of the stalls will be assigned on a first come first served basis. Stalling available in the Expo Hall and Hall of Education at \$110.00 per stall (cement floor). All stalls have full doors.

Due to parking restrictions and for safety reasons, no horses may be shown out of a trailer. Day stalls will be available at \$75.00 NO OVERNIGHT.

### **FACILITIES** cont'd

Stall Panels must not be removed for special set ups, but may be folded or pinned back and tied as long as they remain adjacent to the stall. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for any stall panel moved and will be billed to your account. At the end of the show you must contact the Barn Manager: Bill Amen, cell: 303.809.6352, to show the panel(s) were replaced to their original position with pins. At that point the \$25.00 fee per panel will be credited back to your account. Any stalls damaged will be charged to the exhibitor.

**STABLING AVAILABILITY:** Move in available Monday, August 16. All stalls must be vacated on Monday, August 23rd by 8:00 am. Groups wishing to be stalled together must note that in the space provided on the entry form. Early arrivals prior to August 16th or late departures after August 23rd at 8:00 am, per horse per day, will be charged \$30 per stall. Tack stalls may be limited to 50% of the number of horses entered per stabled barn. Barn Manager: Bill Amen, cell: 303.809.6352.

**STALL DECORATIONS:** *BEFORE DECORATING*, please check with the Show Manager or the Barn Manager for fire regulations. Aisles must not be blocked.

NON-COMPETING HORSES: Horses that are not competing at the Region 8 show must sign a USEF and AHA waiver at the show office.

**SHAVINGS AND FEED:** Official vendor on grounds is Bill Amen, B & T Feed, 303.809.6352. Call to have shavings delivered and ready and waiting for you at your stalls. No other vendors will be allowed. Shavings and feed availability hours will be posted.

**ARENA AND WARM UP:** The Events Center main arena is 150' x 300'. The paddock arena is 85' x 185' and the Stadium arena is 90' x 190'. The footing in all arenas is a mix of sand and loam.

CAMPERS: Only electric hook ups are available, \$60.00 per night. Limited availability, no advance reservations.

**CONCESSIONS:** Will be available on grounds. Any barn parties must be arranged through Cater West, as they have an exclusive concession contract for all food and liquor at the facility. Call Cater West, 303.291.2565.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

DOGS: Per National Western contract dogs will not be allowed in the National Western Complex. All dogs on the grounds must be on a leash at all times.

PARKING AND TRAILER AREAS: There will be no horse trailer parking adjacent to the stall area (except for loading and unloading). All horse trailers will be parked under the direction of the National Western Staff.

### THE BREEDERS CHALLENGE FUTURITY SHOW RULES:

#### **SHOWING & JUDGING**

The Breeders Challenge Futurity 2020 breeding classes will be held at the REGION 8 SHOW AT THE NATIONAL WESTERN COMPLEX, EVENT CENTER ARENA ON Saturday AUGUST 21, 2021. FUTURITY classes are LOCAL RULES DESIGNATED but shall follow AHA and USEF rules, and, as such, do not garner points or qualifications.

ENTRY DEADLINE FOR CABA SPONSORED FUTURITY CLASSES, EXCEPT WEANLINGS, is AUGUST 12, 2021, NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED (IF MAILED, MUST BE POSTMARKED BY THE DEADLINE DATE) and are to be mailed to:

CABA Show Secretary, c/o Liz Wheeler 6786 Cherry Creek Rd, Franktown, CO 80116

(Check made out to Colorado Arabian Breeders Alliance, or CABA)

Entry Forms are to include class entry fees only. Horse's registration to accompany entry. All other show related fees such as stalling fees, admin fees, etc. shall be payable to the REGION 8 SHOW, using the REGION 8 entry form, and will be required to be submitted to REGION 8 SHOW Secretary, even if only Futurity classes are entered. Futurity exhibitors shall be subject to all REGION 8 SHOW rules and regulations. If the horse is ONLY in the CABA Futurity classes, deduct \$40.00 from the Regional Mandatory fees for the 9-90 (\$20), recovery (\$15) & the Recognition fee (\$5).

### ENTRY FORMS FOR CABA CLASSES CAN BE FOUND ON THE CABA WEBSITE

AWARDS – Cash prize paybacks will be at the sole discretion of CABA and the administrator of the Breeders Challenge Futurity program. Prize monies will be determined by the number of nominations and resultant entries in each age group, sponsorships, and other revenues generated by CABA. The minimum guaranteed payback for each class will be published on the entry form for each year's Futurity.

### **RULES & PROCEDURES FOR FUTURITY CLASSES**

Judging System-Handlers for all Futurity classes must be Amateurs (ATH) and must meet all USEF amateur requirements. The number of judges will be determined by CABA and the Futurity Administrator. Classes will be conducted in accordance with AHA/USEF Halter Rules. Each participant is responsible for knowledge of these rules and is subject to these rules. The CABA BOD and the Futurity Administrator RESERVE THE RIGHT TO COMBINE CLASSES AT THEIR DISCRETION. Any questions that may arise which are not covered by AHA/USEF Rules will be resolved by the CABA governing body. All entries will be judged independently and by the panel of judges. Judges will examine all horses individually while walking, trotting, and standing. Horses will enter the ring in a counter-clockwise direction in chronological age order (according to date of birth) from oldest to youngest. Horses will be encouraged to move with elegance, impulsion, and charismatic animation at the trot, exhibiting authentic Arabian type. Following the trot into the arena, each entry shall proceed to the far end. All entries

Immediately following the individual presentations at the trot all horses shall walk in a clockwise direction around the arena. Horses to circle at a controlled walk around the ring at the discretion of the judge and at the instruction of the ring steward.

Horses will be presented to the judging panel for evaluation in a controlled, yet uninhibited and non-intimidated manner. Horses are encouraged to exhibit Arabian presence. The use of a standard halter show whip is allowed but not mandatory. These procedures will apply for all yearling, two year old and three year old horses.

More than one horse may be exhibited by a handler in the same class provided that an additional, designated, handler(s) is/are available to take over the horse not being presented, and, provided that the additional handler(s) is/are available for each horse during the initial entry, group judging and awards presentation.

#### NOTICE AND EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

(quote from USEF document dated April 27, 2016)

"... AR116.6a3 will allow shanking in Arabian Halter classes or competitions only in emergency situations where a horse becomes dangerously unruly and immediate shanking is required in order to regain control of the horse and prevent imminent harm to the horse or others.

In conjunction with AR115.1, with the exception of emergency circumstances where the horse is physically out of control and creating imminent danger to itself or others, from the date of the ruling forward, the threatening use of a whip (or potentially other objects) as a visual cue while preparing or presenting a horse in Arabian Halter classes or competitions must be recognized as intimidating behavior that is disallowed under AR115 and the general provisions of GR839".

### CONTROLLED PADDOCK

Since the controlled paddock was first instituted, the use of large plastic bags and other items has escalated well beyond what is necessary to assist our in-hand horses into the arena. Additionally, we have erred by not clearly stating how this one specified person appointed by either the show

committee or the exhibitor is to go about assisting with entrance(s) into the arena. EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY (per USEF and AHA directive), the one specified person assisting with entrance of in-hand horses into the show ring will be allowed to use only the same length whip and appendages as are currently allowed for the individual handling the horse. Rule reference AR114.2: WHIPS ARE TO BE NO LONGER THAN 6', INCLUDING APPENDAGES. SMALL APPENDAGES (NO MORE THAN 12" IN LENGTH) OR RIBBON, PLASTIC, ETC. ARE PERMITTED. The designated person will not hit or use any other objects, such as trash cans, walls, etc., to make any noise. In addition, effective immediately, the use of plastic or paper bags of any type or size is prohibited in assisting with entrance(s) into the arena.

It is the responsibility of Show Management, along with the USEF Steward(s), to ensure the "designated person" understands this policy and their role. Should this rule/policy be violated a warning card may be issued to both the handler and the "designated person", or groom, who initiates this violation. "Alternatively, the horse may be disqualified from this Futurity competition by the Judge(s) or at the discretion of CABA and the CBC FUTURITY ADMINISTRATOR."

CLASSES: Purebred Arabian and Half-Arabian halter classes shall be held for the following age groups: Yearling, Two (2) Year Old, and Three (3) Year Old. The CABA BOD and the Futurity Administrator reserve the right to combine classes at their discretion up to the start of the show.

- 4. PAYOUT WILL BE TO 5 PLACES (CHAMPION, RES CHAMPION, AND 3 TOP FIVES) WITH A CLASS OF 9 OR MORE ENTRIES
- 5. PAYOUT WILL BE TO 4 PLACES (CHAMPION, RES CHAMPION, AND 2 TOP FIVES) WITH A CLASS OF 7 OR 8 ENTRIES
- 6. PAYOUT WILL BE TO 3 PLACES (CHAMPION, RES CHAMPION, AND 1 TOP FIVE) WITH A CLASS OF 5 OR 6 ENTRIES
- 7. PAYOUT WILL BE TO 2 PLACES (CHAMPION AND RES CHAMPION) WITH A CLASS OF 2, 3, OR 4 ENTRIES
